In this essay, please address what you see as the most significant challenges the security industry will be facing in the next two decades and how you see addressing them. You may wish to tackle factors in industrial security: corporate, manufacturing, commercial, international business, healthcare, private, etc. or in the law enforcement arena: municipal policing, corrections, community-based enforcement, anti-terrorism, etc.

Your essay will first identify current practices in your area of focus and what shortcomings you find in current practices. Then your essay will identify the challenges you see ahead and how you foresee addressing them. Be specific rather than general.
